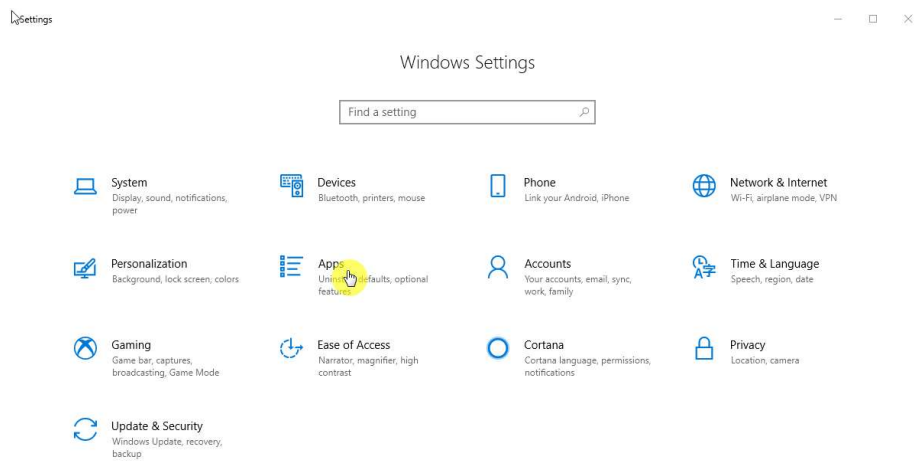

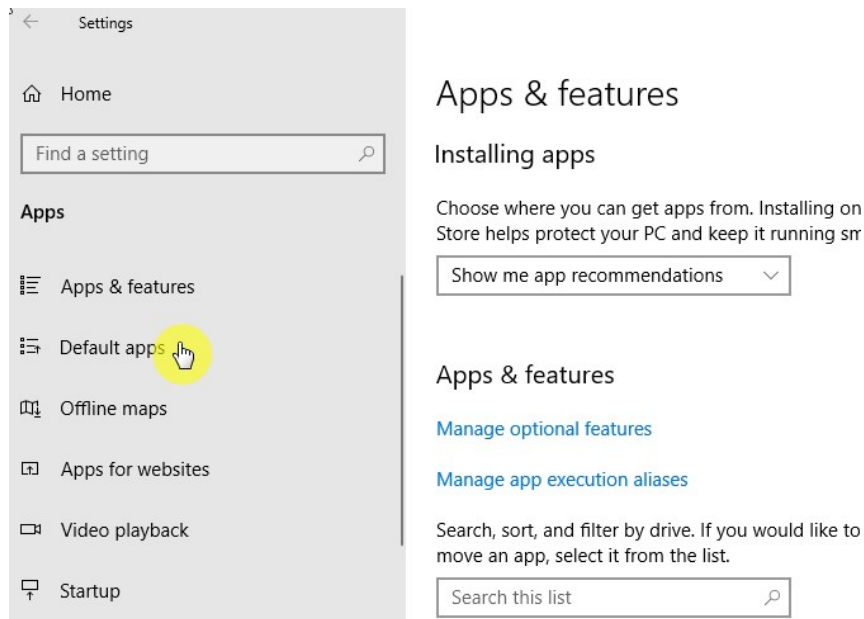
1. Open Settings by click start in the bottom left corner

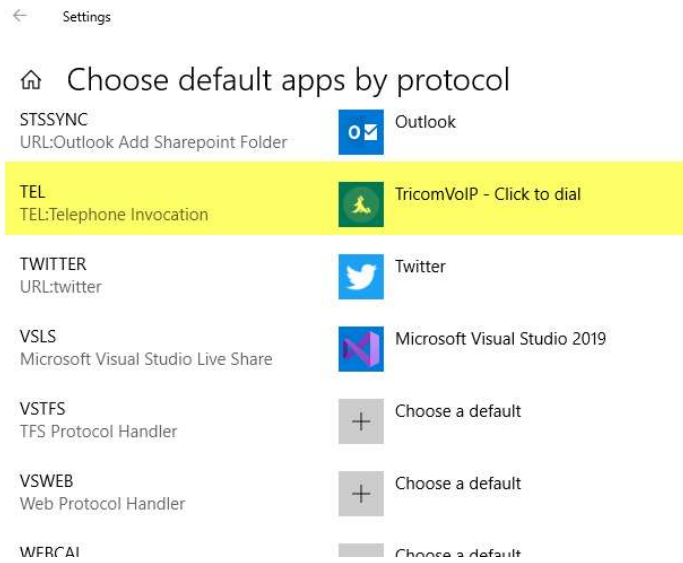

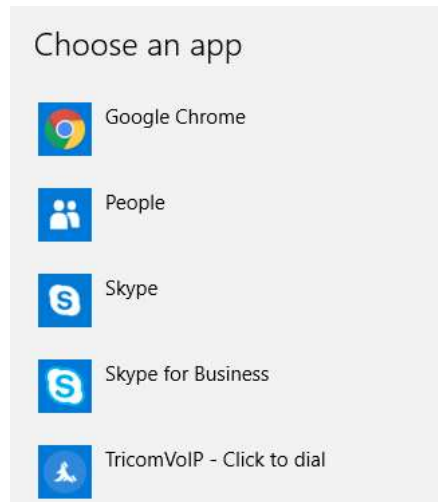
Select which apps to use to listen to music, look at pictures, check mail, watch videos, and more.

this should be set to 'TricomVoIP – Click to Dial' – if doesn't then simply click the icon to re-assign the TEL extension to TricomVoIP as pictured in step 7.

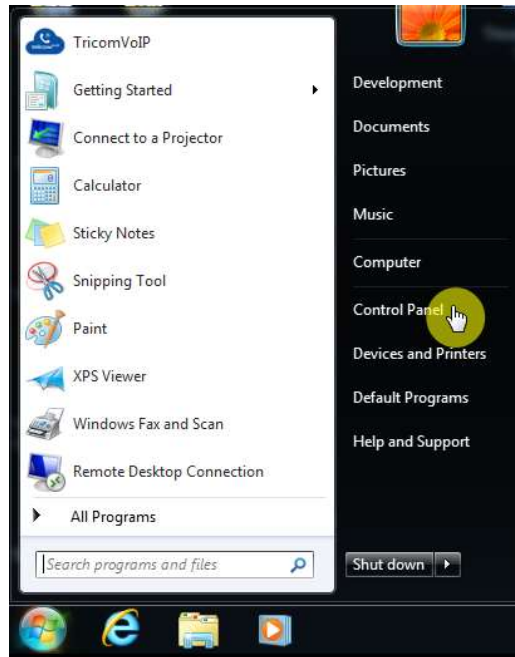


7. Image of Re-assigning

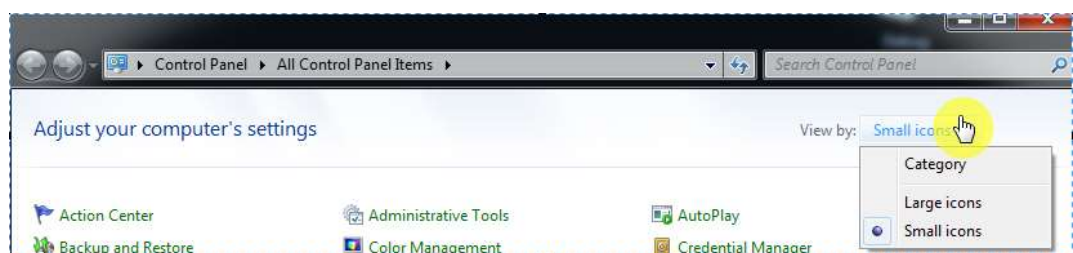

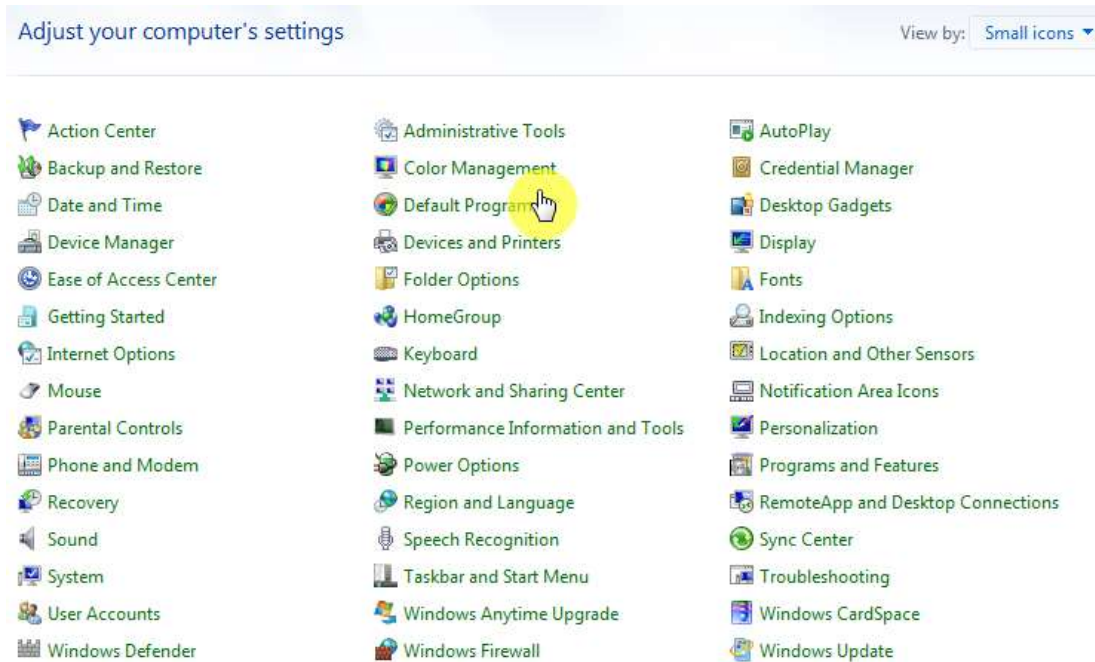
1. Click the 'Start' icon in the bottom left of your screen to open the following menu



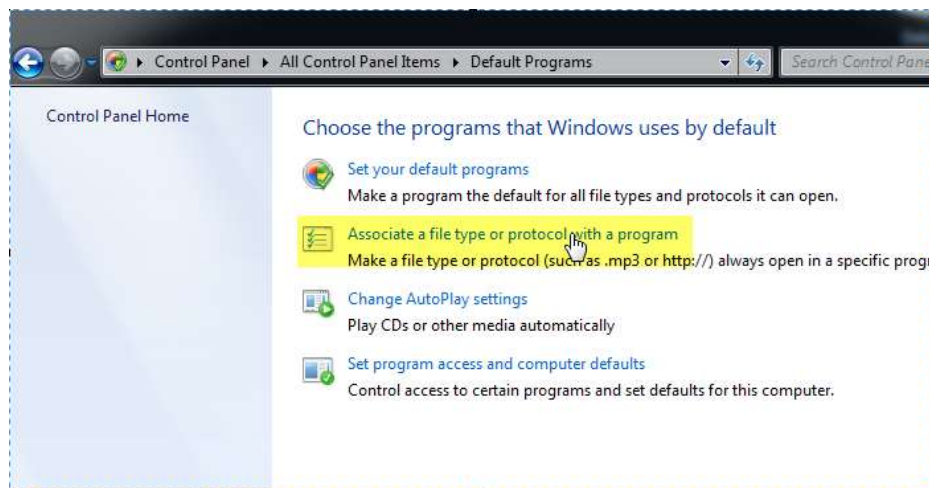
2. Click 'Control Panel' as pictured above.

4. Once view is small Icons, Click 'Default Programs' as pictured below

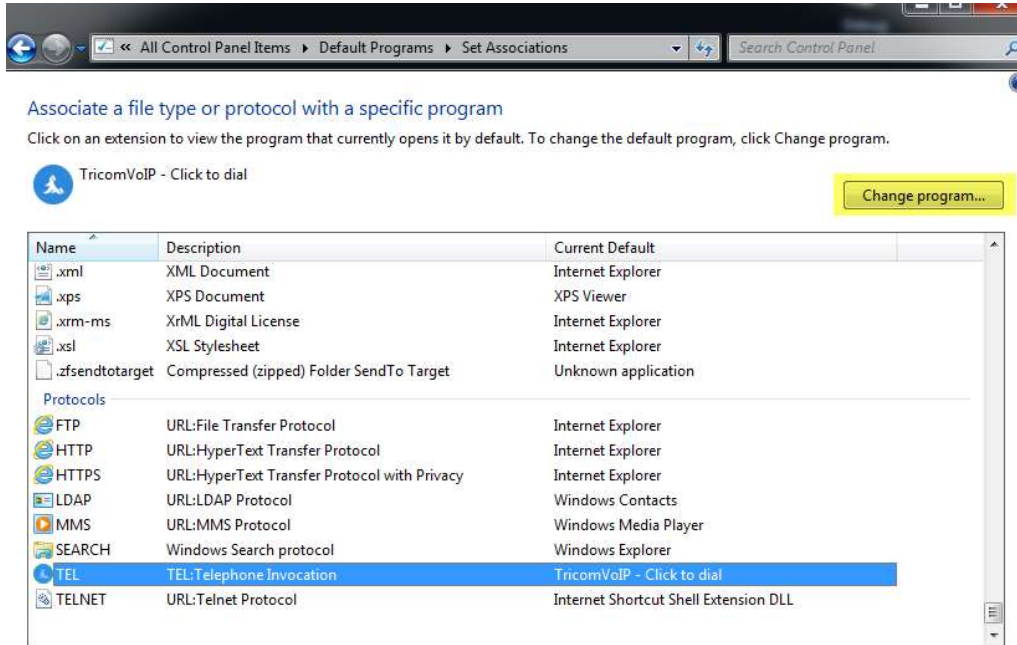


5. In the default programs menu select 'Associate a file type or protocol with a program.'



6. Scroll to the bottom of the 'Set Associations' Window and verify TricomVoIP is select to handle TEL (TEL:Telephone Invocation)
